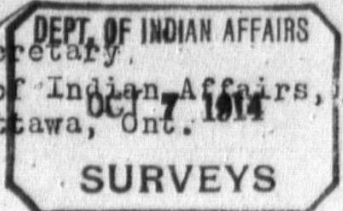

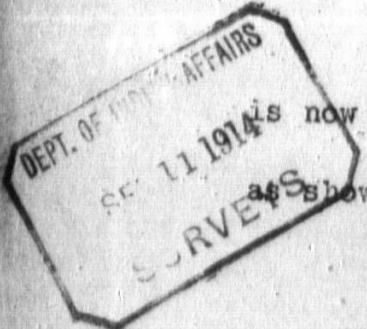

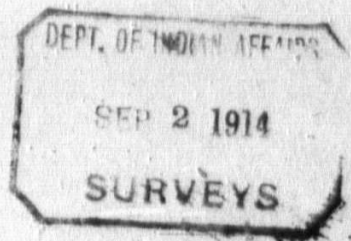
Brocket Station Grounds, Crows Nest Subdiv.
