

Notes of Survey
Capt Joseph Foster's property at
Boat Harbour Pictou N.S.

I spent a half a day on Dec^r. 1909 preparing for the Survey of this property, unfortunately the weather turned out to be wet and stormy for some time afterwards so that nothing was done until August & September of this year, the same preparations required to be made again and on August 20th we began the Survey.

In order to get some definite point to work from I was compelled to produce the eastern line of the Matthew E. Spruell lot from a point nearly a half mile back from Boat Harbour, then at its intersection with a certain small brook and the shore of Boat Harbour marked a point on the rear line of the Fisher Grant lots, thence I had to produce this line until it intersected with the Charles Spruell lot which marked a corner or starting point, and from this corner I began the Survey, as not a line or a corner could be found on the Capt Joseph Foster property had it not been for the point given me on the M. E. Spruell line I doubt if I could have located the lines and corner, as the wood is all second growth and not a vestige of a mark to be found anywhere, the corner are now well marked and the lines well blazed around the entire lot.
