gratification for the inspiring evidences which your deliberations have revealed of the unity of the Canadian people, at this critical hour in their history.

Let us pray that the fateful days which lie ahead may be illumined by the spirit of the national effort which you have determined should be made by Canada to defeat the cause of liberty and the free way of life.
