Sir,

With reference to letter to you of the 27th February and previous correspondence regarding the appointment of Dr D.J. McDonald as medical attendant to the Naas River Indians, I beg to say that the Department has been given to understand that the doctor has been on duty since the 1st October last. I therefore enclose herewith cheque No 1861 for \$360.00 in payment of his salary at the rate of \$60.00 per month from 1st October, 1907 to the 31st March, 1908. Before handing over this cheque you should satisfy yourself that ~~the~~ doctor has (as is understood) performed the duties of his office for the period stated.

I may add that it is expected that Dr McDonald will continue to reside at Kincolith, and attend the Indians. You may therefore place his name on the monthly pay-list.
