Tabling of orders and regulations.

9. Every order or regulation passed under the authority of this Act shall be tabled in Parliament forthwith if Parliament is in session, and, if Parliament is not in session, within two weeks of the opening of the session next following the making of such order or regulation.

Report to Parliament. 10. The Minister shall lay before Parliament, within thirty days after the commencement of each session thereof, a report containing a statement of the operations of the Department during the year then last preceding.

Penalties.

11. The Governor in Council may prescribe the penalties 10 that may be imposed by fine or imprisonment or by fine and imprisonment for violations of this Act or of orders and regulations made thereunder, and may also prescribe whether such penalties shall be imposed upon summary conviction or upon indictment, but no such penalty shall 15 exceed a fine of five thousand dollars or imprisonment for a term of five years, or both such fine and imprisonment.
