Special Conditions

1. That no timber shall be cut smaller than a diameter of eight inches measured breast high:
2. That all merchantable timber shall be cut and removed and paid for, and that all timber cut shall be fully utilized and that any wastage of such timber products shall be considered a breach of contract;
3. That all logs cut shall be properly measured and scaled by a duly qualified person appointed by the Forest Service Branch, Department of Lands and Forests, Victoria B.C., and that all logs shall be marked with a descriptio mark "I.R." and any other mark properly appointed by the Forest Service Branch, Department of Lands and Forests, Victoria

Forests, Victoria, B.C.; 4. Wood fuel to be made available to the Indians and to be hauled to Indian households in the area as far as Nanaimo.

5. That the licensee shall pay on the signing of this license a license or registration fee of \$50.00 and a deposit of \$250.00 as a guarantee that the provisions of this license shall be satisfactorily complied with, which deposit shall be forfeited to the Department if the undertaking is not completed to the satisfaction of the Minister of Mines and Resources as provided for in Clause 5 of the Timber Regulations;

6. That the licensee shall comply in all respects with such laws and regulations as may be imposed by the Government of the Province of British Columbia in connection with the disposal of slash and debris resulting from the cutting operations, and the protection and fighting of forest fires; 7. That preference shall be given in the way of

7. That preference shall be given in the way of employment to the Indians of the Chemainus and Sickameen Bands, owners of the Reserve, in so far as this may be done in the economical carrying out of the logging operations.

8. That at all times a person or persons authorized by the Minister of Mines and Resources to do so may make an inspection of the operation and have access to all scale sheets, records, etc., directly connected with the operation of cutting and removing this timber.
