37. The Cabinet approved the recommendation of the Minister of Justice and agreed that His Honour Judge Edmond Proulx be retired on account of age and that, pursuant to Section 25 of the Judges Act, 1946, he be granted an annuity of \$5,000; an Order in Council to be passed accordingly.
