1. The following report of accident involving the above noted aircraft is submitted for your information and record, please.

1. Date of Accident: December 22nd, 1951
2. Place: Baie St. Paul, Québec.
3. Type of aircraft: Stinson 108
4. Pilot's Name: G. Lafrenière Licence: C-5711
5. Number of people injured, (if any) nil
6. Extent of injuries, (if applicable) nil

7. Extent of damage to aircraft: Right wing: bent spars. Five broken ribs. Right strut bent. Left wing tip damaged.

8. Type of flying, (Private, Commercial, etc.) Commercial.

9. Summary of events immediately prior to and including the accident:
Pilot took off from field and when 10 feet off the ground made right turn to avoid obstruction ahead. While turning right, wing tip touched a fence. Aircraft lost flying speed and fell on the ground, snapping left wing tip.

10. Opinion as to the cause of the accident: Pilot ~~at~~ attempting turn with insufficient airspeed.

11. Remarks: Letter of warning will be sent to pilot.
