THE Board of Management of the Children's Aid Society of Toronto appeals to the benevolent and philanthropic people of the city and country for help for the purpose of providing a Shelter in connection with the work of the Society. The lease of the old St. James' Rectory, which has been used as the Society's Shelter for nearly eight years, is about to expire, and cannot be renewed. This made it necessary to find a new Shelter. After much consideration and after looking at a number of properties, the Board finally decided to purchase the property formerly occupied by the late Chief Justice Sir John Hagarty, situated on Simcoe Street. The house and grounds are large and can, with reasonable expenditure, be made to meet present needs.
