- tisane**, *f.* infusion, herb tea, broth.
- tison**, *m.* firebrand.
- toi**, thee, thou, you.
- toit**, *m.* roof.
- tombée**, *f.* fall; — de la nuit, nightfall.
- tomber**, to fall, let fall.
- ton, ta**, thy, your.
- ton**, *m.* tone; **d'un** —, in a tone.
- tondeur**, *m.* shearer.
