Stipendiary Magistrate, Henry Pryor, D. C. L.

The City Civil Court, presided over by the Stipendiary Magistrate (having jurisdiction of sums up to \$30), is held in the City Court House, Market Square, on the second and fourth Tuesday of every month.

The City Criminal Court meets on the first and third Wednesday of each month, and is also presided over by the Stipendiary Magistrate, having jurisdiction on all statuabie offences, except treason, homicide, burglary, and arson. Clerk of the above Courts, the City Clerk, or Asst. Clerk.

The Police Office is open every week day, from 10 to 3 o'clock, (except on Saturday when it closes at 1 P.M.) The administration of Police and all executive powers of the corporation is vested in the Stipendiary Magistrate.
