Blackwell on the title page, which last we take to be that of the well-known Scottish critic and scholar of the last century.

A German Theologian and Orientalist who became Hebrew professor at Heidelberg. His learning was varied and profound, and he is known as the ESBRA and STRABO of GERMANY. The above edition of the Hebrew Bible has in addition to the Latin text, extensive Hebrew and Latin notes.
