

WAS A WOMAN OF MYSTERY.

STRANGE LIFE ENDED BY MISS WELLS' DEATH.

Brutally Murdered in a Villa Quarter of Naples—She was Probably an American—Very Secretive and Suspicious, but a Lady Always—Banned, Assaulted and Slain.

LONDON, Jan. 4.—The alleged English woman who was murdered in Naples a few days ago today was associated for ten years in Naples with Pastor Barff of the English Church there, without either Mr. Barff or his congregation learning anything whatever of her past history. She was always regarded in Naples as a secretive and most eccentric woman, who took special pains to court obscurity.

On the night the woman was murdered she was on her way to dine at the Villa Quarter. She lived in the Villa Quattro, in Posillipo, about one mile away from Barff's house. In the morning she was found in her house dead, having been strangled by the hands of a murderer.

The British Consul accordingly wrote the Italian authorities asking for the woman's body to be sent to England for burial. The Italian authorities refused to do so, and the woman's body was buried in the Villa Quarter.

When Miss Wells left the Hermitage six weeks ago she turned the key in the door and gave no further account of herself. The house remains to-day exactly as she left it.
