Define the word translucent. The dictionary defines it thus: "Transmitting rays of light, but not so as to render the form or color of objects beyond distinctly visible.

Is water which is not whipped into foam translucent? It is both translucent and transparent.

Are all translucent bodies transparent? Some translucent bodies are transparent, others are not

Which translucent bodies are not transparent? Those which, while transmitting rays of light, have not the property of being distinctly seen through.

Name a few translucent bodies which are not transparent. Paper, porcelain, white cotton, white linen, white silk, opaline, some kinds of amber, etc., etc.

Are all transparent bodies translucent? Yes all transparent bodies are translucent. They cannot be transparent unless they are translucent.

Name some transparent bodies. Glass, water, clear ice, clear amber, etc.

The highest part of a wave is called its crest, can you make a verb of the name-word crest? Yes I can make a verb of the name-word crest. Do so. To crest.

If I say the waves are crested with foam what do I mean? You mean that the highest part of the waves is white, or is covered with foam.

Small crests of foam are called what? Or What are small crests of foam called? They are called white-caps.

What causes the foam on waves? Violent agitation of the water causes the foam on waves.

The foam on waves is caused by what? Or By what is the foam on waves caused? It is caused by the violent agitation or lashing of the water.

What force sometimes violently agitates the sea or lashes it into fury? The force which sometimes violently agitates or lashes the sea into fury is the wind.

Is the wind which violently agitates the sea or lashes it into fury a gentle wind? No the wind which lashes the sea into fury is not a gentle wind.

What sort of wind is it? It is a strong wind a high wind, a heavy wind, a powerful wind, a terrible wind, a violent wind, a hurricane.

Is it only on the top of the waves that there is foam? No there is foam in the air too. Or No the air also is full of foam.

In the boat whom do you see? Or Whom do you see in the boat? In the boat I see two men and a boy.

Where are the men? One is at the front the other at the back of the boat.

Where is the boy? He is between the two men at about the middle of the boat.
