Opium is higher, the usual reports are coming to hand showing that snow, frost, rain and drought have all combined against the poppy, and report is that this year's crop will be very small, probably 3,000 cases. Norway cod liver oil, 1898, is worth \$1.50 per gal. Sulphur is much higher.

England.

LONDON, April 27th, 1898.

The market has shown some effects of the American-Spanish war, and quinine has naturally been first affected. It has advanced this week 3 or 4 cents per oz., and is very firm. Opium, morphine, and ipecac have also risen. Camphor is easier and cassia lower. Phenazone is dearer, as manufacturers have combined, and no further reduction has taken place in antipyrin. Fixed oils and turpentine show small advances. Cod-liver oil in spite of alarmist reports is dull. Quicksilver and mercurials are unaltered, but
