

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the Honourable Senator Robertson moved that the Bill (218), intituled: "An Act to authorize the Minister of Finance, with the approval of the Governor in Council, to enter into an Agreement with the Province of Alberta to amend the Agreement entered into with that Province under the authority of the Dominion-Provincial Taxation Agreement Act, 1942," be now read a second time.

After debate,

It was resolved in the affirmative.

Ordered, That a Message be sent to the House of Commons to acquaint that House that the Senate have passed this Bill, without any amendment.

Referred to the Standing Committee on Banking and Commerce.

The Order of the Day being called for resuming the adjourned debate on the inquiry by the Honourable Senator Dupuis—That he will call the attention of the Senate to the desirability of establishing a national organization in co-operation with all the Provincial Governments whose functions would be to help mothers, to develop infant health and to reduce to its minimum infantile mortality, it was—

Ordered, That the said Order of the Day be postponed until to-morrow.
