progress of the Spanish arms and colonies in that quarter of the globe. He says, "he had made some progress in the History of British America;" and he announces his intention to return to that part of his Work, as soon as the ferment which at that time prevailed in the British Colonies in America, should subside, and regular government be re-established. Various causes concurred in preventing him from fulfilling his intention.

DURING the course of a tedious illness, which he early foresaw would
have a fatal termination, Dr. Robertson
at different times destroyed many of
his papers. But after his death, I
found that part of the History of British
America which he had wrote many
years before, and which is now offered
to the Public. It is written with his
own hand, as all his Works were; it
is as carefully corrected as any part
of his Manuscripts which I have ever
seen; and he had thought it worthy
