

THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL J².

An Act for the relief of Chia Hannah Shiff.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Chia Hannah Shiff, residing at the city of Montreal, in the province of Quebec, factory employee, wife of Samuel Shiff, otherwise known as Samuel Shiffman, tailor, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at the said city of Montreal, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the twenty-eighth day of May, A.D. 1920, at the city of Slutzk, in the province of Minsk, in Russia, she then being Chia Hannah Gutzeit, a spinster; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, because of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have been proved by evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage dissolved.

1. The said marriage between Chia Hannah Gutzeit and Samuel Shiff, otherwise known as Samuel Shiffman, her husband, is hereby dissolved, and shall be henceforth null and void to all intents and purposes whatsoever.

Right to marry again.

2. The said Chia Hannah Gutzeit may at any time hereafter marry any man whom she might lawfully marry if the said marriage with the said Samuel Shiff, otherwise known as Samuel Shiffman had not been solemnized.
