INDUSTRIES.

Moose Jaw has one very large industry in the Saskatchewan Flour Mills, one of the largest in the West, with a capacity of 2,200 barrels per day. There are a number of smaller industries, such as machine shops, planing mills, sash and door factories, lumber yards and about a dozen wholesale distributing houses and more arranging to locate there.

Gordon Ironsides and Fares of Winnipeg have signed an agreement with the City Council and have acquired a large block of land near the stockyards to establish a large meat packing house in Moose Jaw as their Western headquarters.

The City has two daily newspapers and nine Banks, several of which are housed in magnificent buildings.
