BY-LAWS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STEPHEN.

Furthermore, be it enacted by the authority aforesaid, that it shall not be lawful for any person to ride or drive over any bridge in this township, exceeding 30 feet in length, at a faster pace than a walk; and any person riding or driving over any such bridge at a faster pace than a walk shall be liable to a fine of not less than one dollar nor more than twenty dollars, and all fines imposed by this By-law shall be recoverable, with costs, before any of Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace having jurisdiction in this municipality; and further be it enacted that all By-laws, or parts of By-laws of this municipality contrary to the provisions of this By-law are recinced.
