

**BY-LAWS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF STEPHEN.**

Furthermore, be it enacted by the authority aforesaid, that it shall not be lawful for any person to ride or drive over any bridge in this township, exceeding 30 feet in length, at a faster pace than a walk ; and any person riding or driving over any such bridge at a faster pace than a walk shall be liable to a fine of not less than one dollar nor more than twenty dollars, and all fines imposed by this By-law shall be recoverable, with costs, before any of Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace having jurisdiction in this municipality ; and further be it enacted that all By-laws, or parts of By-laws of this municipality contrary to the provisions of this By-law are rescinded.
