The Fish and Game Department possesses ample information regarding territories which may be leased, and is always ready to impart it to those desirous of acquiring a tract for hunting and fishing purposes.

The Local Government fully realizes the importance of encouraging the formation of fish and game clubs, which, through their guardians, render such effective aid in the protection of fish and game ; and does so to the
