LITTLE BOY KILLED BY TRAIN

Train Running Thru Farm Property Ends Life of a Two-Year-Old. Woodbridge, June 8.—About 10.30 this morning a fatal accident took place between Woodbridge and Hammer Summit, when Samuel Punnett's second youngest child, George, aged two years, was instantly killed by an excursion train to Niagara Falls, which passed thru here. The railway track runs thru the farm. The hired man and the little fellow's brother went across the track to the other field. Little George attempted to follow. It is thought he was looking at the approaching train when death overtook him.

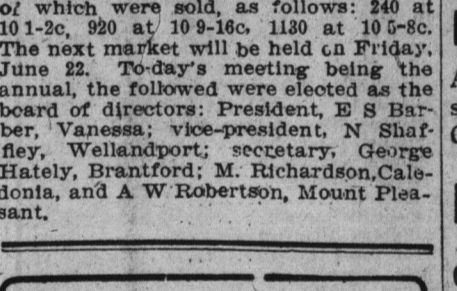

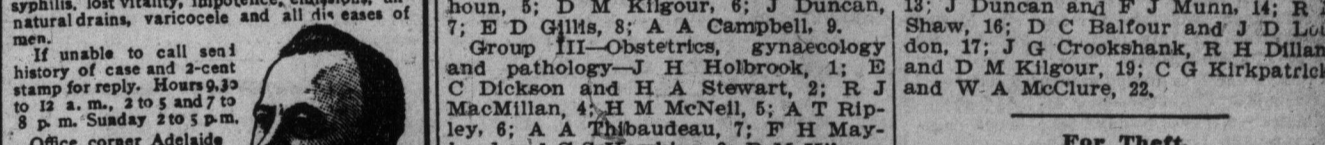
