Much Manufacturing in West.

'Mr. McKinnon stated that the product of the factories of the seven hundred members of the Manufacturers' Assoication west of the great lakes might be estimated at \$400,000,000,000 for this calendar year. Indus-000 for this calendar year. Indus-trialism had spread westward to the extent of 45 factories each year since the present century's beginning, he


