In the present year the existing leases of the Park lots property belonging to this congregation will fall in. In renewing them the Church Trustees should not forget that property involves duties as well as rights. It is the duty of the Rector and Churchwardens to obtain as large an income as is fairly possible; and on the other hand they feel bound to remember that the owners of so large a property have it in their power to largely affect, beneficially or the reverse, the character of the property and the well-being of their tenants. Your Trustees are determined not to suffer this large property to become, as is too usual in the case of church leaseholds, by reason of the terms of the leases, a block to the improvement of the neighborhood, and a scandal to the owners. A resolution giving power to the Rector and Churchwardens to prevent this result will be submitted.
