PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND HAS MADE GOOD PROGRESS **ALONG EDUCATIONAL LINES**

Brief History of Manual Training and Nature Study as Taught in the Island Province- -Opening of the Macdonald Consolidated School at Hillsborough, Marked An Important Epoch.

CHARLOTTETOWN, P. E. I. Dec. 18-On a beautiful afternoon in August last, when the summer sun shining from an unclouded sky revealed in all its glory our rich agricultural heritage, the first Maddonald Consolidated School in this province was formally opened, the dedica-tion ceremonies of a new temple of learn-ing successfully performed, and an import. (4)—Providing a course of instruction in Household Science for young women at Macdonald Hall, Guelph. All four parts of the plan are now in op-eration in Prince Edward Island. The Macdonald Consolidated School at Hills-borough represents the union of five dis-tructs. It was built at a cost of \$25,000, after the most approved plans. It has six class rooms, a farge assembly hall, with a seating capacity of 600, large cor-ridor, teachers' room and cloak rooms. There are two large playrooms, each with

The building is as hygienically perfect almost, with respect to lighting, heating and toilet facihties, as present day knowledge and skill can make it. It has modern equipment for Nature Study, (with the essential school garden), manual training and domestic science. 


