**ARREST OPIUM**  
**GANG AND FOIL**  
**\$2,400,000 PLOT**

**Round-up Follows Weeks of**  
**Sleuthing by Federal and**  
**Local Agents—U. S. Ware-**  
**house is Used.**

One of the biggest conspiracies ever hatched to flood America with contraband smoking opium was squelched by Federal and local authorities last night when they pounced upon a gang whose arrests, they said, would yield \$2,400,000 worth of the drug.

The arrests came as the result of weeks of patient detective work and careful counter-plotting in which William H. Williams, Chief Special Agent of the Treasury, and Dr. Carleton Simon, head of the police narcotic squad, combined forces.

The hero of the dramatic climax to the investigators' work, which came in Chinatown last night, was a 16-year-old office boy employed by Williams whose quick-wittedness prevented the escape of the suspected men when they became suspicious that Mott street was thickly planted with detectives ready to seize them.

The gang rounded up last night, according to the authorities, had conspired—and for a time successfully carried out—the nearest scheme yet devised to cheat the Federal and State narcotic laws. They had chosen for themselves the name of an importing firm, and trading under that name, had imported into this country 4,000 pounds of gum cotton, worth at retail prices \$200 a pound. The conspirators had carried on an elaborate "export trade" with foreign
