REPORT OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF NISBET

Rev. Archibald Lee, Chairman.

The Trustees of Nisbet Academy beg to report that nothing was effected during the year 1896 as to the re-establishment of a school for young ladies at Prince Albert, as no suitable building could be procured. The Board feel that it is unwise to attempt the work of a Ladies School without a suitable building and a competent staff of teachers. They think a suitable building for the accommodation of ten pupils should be erected.

The Trustees desire to know whether or not the funds held in trust by the Geueral Assembly would be available, to the amount of three or four thousand dollars, should they desire to erect a building next summer.
