Detroit, Mich., July 17.—Ten thousand people saw Electa, a four-year-old black mare, win the \$10,000 stakes for 224 class trotters at the Grand Circuit track this afternoon and lower the record for the race from 2:05 1/2 to 2:04 1/2.

Electa won in straight heats, doing the second mile in 2:04 1/2, the first half in 1:05 1/2. The interest of the event was in the struggle for second place between Trossie and Helen, the former winning.

In the 2:30 trot Fanny Rice won as she tended to add interest to the event by putting Walter Cox up behind Parker G.
