## ADDITIONS TO LIBRARY.

A large number of blue books from Canadian and American Government Departments, with works of a statistical nature presented by societies and individuals, have been added to our library during the past year. The library is frequently sought by members of the Board, and citizens generally, for the information which it contains.
