ALLIES FORM HIGH COUNCIL

Principal Reason for Briand's Visit to Italy Was This.

ONE IDEA AND ONE SCOPE

No Longer Separate Wars, But One War Against One Enemy.

(By Andre Beaumont.)

Milan, Feb. 13.—An official communication issued in Rome confirms the news I wired on Thursday that

one of the principal objects of Premier Briand's visit to Italy is the constitution of a High Council of the Entente powers in Paris.

This Council is to be ready for a permanent session. Ten days in advance it will notify the respective governments of the subjects to be discussed, and whenever anything important is to be discussed the council is to meet to discuss it fully and come to a rapid decision upon the course of action.

ONE IDEA IN ONE SCOPE.

Unity of views and policy is to be established between the allied governments, whose diplomacy will thus represent one idea and one scope—that of securing results with the least loss of time.

The delegates will form part of the Council on the express condition that each nation abandons its particular policy, and is to have an eye only to the general interests of all the allied nations.

There is to be no longer French, British, Italian or Russian war, each conducted without reference to the other's wars, but one war against one enemy, who must be crushed by one common effort.

The conditions on which the four nations will establish the High Council are:

First, the absolute immunity of their respective fronts having been secured by each nation, they must be ready to place at the disposal of the other allies their remaining forces.

Second, there must be a frank and loyal declaration by the allies of their material, etc., at their disposal.

Third, the High Council will be assisted by representatives of all the General Staffs, who will give military advice.

These prime objects having been stated, the Council will discuss the secondary questions between the allies, such as trade, industries and finance.

Berlin, Feb. 14, via London 3.20 p.m.—Important gains for the Germans in two engagements were reported to-day by the War Office.

Northwest of Tature positions over a front of 700 yards were captured, 7 officers and 100 men made prisoners.

In the region of Aeneer, near the French frontier, allied positions 400 yards long were captured.
