BILL.

An Act to regulate the sale of Shingles in Lower Canada.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

- 5 1. Every packet of shingles shall be two feet six inches long between the bands, and shall contain fifty rows in height.
 - 2. Each shingle shall be three lines thick, thirteen inches long, and not less than four inches wide.
- 3. The shingles shall be of pine or cedar, free from sapwood, and 10 have the chamfer bevelled off.
 - 4. The name of the vendor shall be carved or marked on each packet.
 - 2. Every person violating this Act shall be liable to a penalty of five Penalty for dollars for each packet of shingles sold contrary to the provisions of contrarent this Act.
