

Certain rules set apart certain days
for certain matters & procedure for day.
When bills are introduced into first
the ministers are responsible for them.
The defeat of the govt on the principle of
a bill (1st reading)

How far govt is responsible for other
measures than their own depends on
the nature and character of the bill

It is powers of Crown

1. to summon
2. to prorogue
3. to dissolve parliament

The summoning of parliament may depend on
certain const. necessities e.g. supply bill etc.

The act of prorogation is act of crown
on advice of ministers

The crown has the const right to refuse
dissolution (1)

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When ought crown to grant dissolution

(1) when a series of bye elections
show that public opinion is against govt
