Mr. King - Principles to be followed:

(Hansard Nov. 25, p.1700-1)

Representation of population -

1. to follow as largely as possible county municipal organizations in defining and delimiting constituencies.
2. Unit of Representation in urban centres necessarily larger than that in rural constituencies.
3. Effort at compactness in shaping constituencies.
4. Equalization of representation as between different urban constituencies and as between different rural constituencies.
5. Members of committee to be fair and just and to apply common sense in framing redistribution map.
