

All Indian Licences are terminable on the 30th April of each year: they may be renewed if it be considered in the interests of the Indians owning the timber. Whether you accept, or not, a renewal of your licence in consideration of paying up to the 30th April 1877 arrears of ground rent as shown in the account enclosed, you, in any case, owe the amount due to the 31st December 1873 and that amount should be paid to the Department forthwith through Mr Belle.
