 the understanding however
 that no such advances will
 hereafter be allowed; and you
 should so notify all parties
 and it will be your duty to
 collect the rent now in arrear
 and as it hereafter falls due
 and forward the same to the
 Department. In any case
 where a Tenant is in arrear
 and you are in doubt as to
 his ability to pay the rent
 you should proceed to collect
 the same under Section 48
 of the Indian Act by distress
 Warrant as in ordinary cases
 of Landlord and Tenant
