I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 23rd Ultime, enclosing cheque for \$3125.45, being payments on lands purchased by you in the Moosamin & Thunderchild Reserve, and in reply have to state that as you were informed in letter of the 27th September last, the interest was reckoned to the 1st November, whereas the money was not forwarded by you until towards the end of that month.
