Referring to letter of the 13th instant respecting Dr. Tisdale's account for attendance upon the Swan Lake Band of Indians, I beg to say that payment has been made from the interest funds of the Indians. This is considered to be a proper charge against such funds; and in future medical attendance will be charged accordingly and you should notify the band. The Department will only pay for medical attendance and supplies, when Indians are without funds of their own.
