

- A. From the same creek but white people use it all.
- Q. Do you know if they have any records there?
- A. I don't know.
- Q. If you got 50 inches of water would that be enough?
- A. There are two places: one goes on one side and the other goes on the other, and we are short of water there.
- Q. If you got all the water there is in that creek would that be enough?
- A. If we got a little more it would be better.
- Q. Are there 50 inches of water running in the creek during the irrigation season?
- A. Yes, I use it all. It is on two places.
- Q. How much land is on the one place?
- A. Six or seven acres on each side. The soil is different in places, but down there it is all sand.
- Q. How many tons of hay do they grow there?
- A. About 5 tons.
- Q. On No. 3 Reserve there are 104 acres; how much of that do you cultivate?
- A. It is all sidehill; we don't use half of that because it is all sidehills.
- Q. Do you cultivate any of it?
- A. Yes, we cultivate the best part of it.
- Q. How much do you cultivate there?
- A. There used to be a good piece of flat there but it has been mined over by a Chinaman.
- Q. How much is cultivated there now?
- A. About 7 acres.
- Q. Any water there?
- A. There is not enough water there.
- Q. Is there any water there at all?
- A. There is a big stream running there.
- Q. Have you a record there?
- A. No.
- Q. Could you cultivate any more land there if you had more water?
