CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE 1.

Aims and Objects of The Great War Veterans' Association of Canada

(a) To perpetuate the close and kindly ties of mutual service in the Great War, the recollections and association of that experience, and to maintain proper standards of dignity and honour between all returned soldiers.

(b) To preserve the memory and records of those who suffered and died for the nation. To see to the erection of monuments to their valor; the provision of suitable burial places; and the establishment of an annual memorial day.

(c) To ensure that proper provision is made for the due care of the sick, wounded and needy among those who have served; including reasonable pensions, employment for such as are capable, soldiers' homes, medical care, and equitable provision for dependent families of enlisted men.
