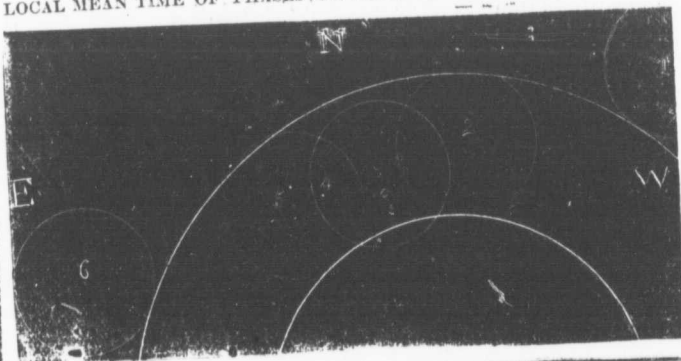

ECLIPSES.

There will be four Eclipses during the year: two of the sun, two of the Moon; which latter will be visible in Charlottetown.

I. A partial eclipse of the Moon, May 22d. Greenwich mean time of opposition, 10h. 47m. 10-7s. At Charlottetown the middle of the eclipse will have passed before the time of moon-rising.
