AN Ingrossed Bill to continue, for a limited time, An Act passed in the thirty-ninth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for granting further encouragement and a more ample allowance to the *Maitres* and *Aides de Poste* in this Province," was read for the third time.

On motion of Mr. *Taschereau*, seconded by Mr. *Martineau*,

RESOLVED, That the Bill do pass and that the title be "An Act to continue, for a limited time, An Act passed in the thirty ninth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for granting further encouragement and a more ample allowance " to the *Maitres* and *Aides de Poste* in this Province,"

ORDERED, That Mr. *Coffin* and Mr. *Raby* do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council and desire their concurrence.
