

The Honorable Mr. *Fergusson Blair*, from the Committee on Standing Orders and Private Bills, to whom was referred the Bill intituled, "An Act to limit the application of a certain general hypothec created by *Daniel McCallum* and his wife, to a certain lot of land," reported that they had gone through the said Bill, and had directed him to report the same with an amendment, which he was ready to submit whenever the House would be pleased to receive it.

Ordered, That the report be now received, and the said amendment being then twice read by the Clerk, and the question of concurrence put thereon, it was agreed to.

The said Bill was then read a third time accordingly.

Ordered, That the Clerk do go down to the Legislative Assembly and acquaint that House that the Legislative Council have passed this Bill, to which they desire their concurrence.

To leave out the word "now," and after "to" to insert "this day three months."
