SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN NORTH-WEST LAND REGULATIONS
A family or any male over 18 years of age may homestead a quarter section of the Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Land Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending homesteader.

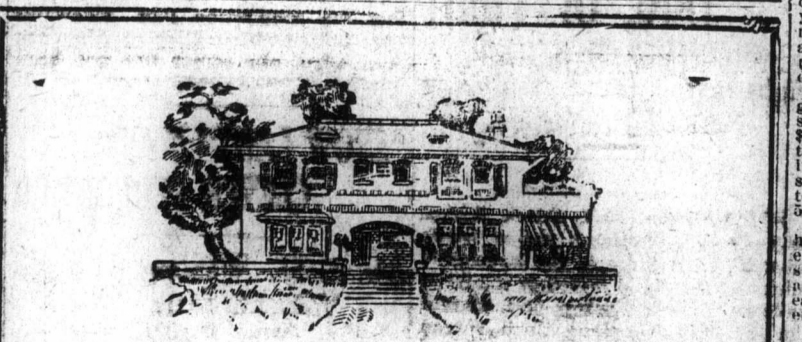
