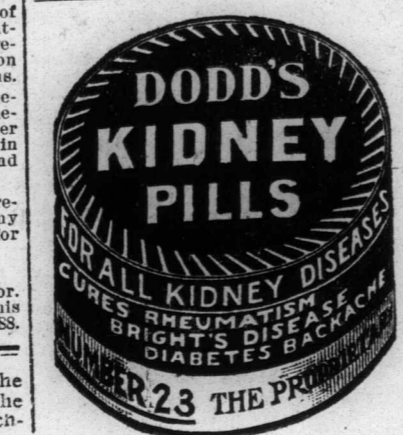

SITUATION IN MEXICO OBSCURE

Where American Troops Are Not Given Out.

By Special Wire to the Courier. El Paso, April 6.—The entire Mexican situation was veiled in obscurity to-day as far as the border was concerned. For the last three days not a single Mexican or American has scanned here from the interior, and the scanty news given out by the Mexican officials at Juarez, as received by telegraph, threw no light on the operations of the troops pursuing Villa beyond confirming the impression that the chase has been practically halted, at least temporarily.
