Poland Are Not Favored.

Long Branch, N.J. Oct. 17-President Wilson announced to-day that his efforts to bring about an agreement among belligerent nations allow relief supplies to be sent to Poland had failed.

The statement follows: "I have now received replies from the King of England, the president of France, the emporer of Russia, the emperor of Germany and the emperor of Austria to my letter of July 20, 1916, in which I tendered the offices of this government in negotiations looking to a fresh consideration of the possibility of method lieving Poland. It appears, I great ly regret to say that there are still important differences between the allied and central powers as to the terms under which relief supplies may be sent to Poland. I am disappointed that I have not yet been successful."
