J. A. Loggie, Native of Loggieville Figures in \$1,000,000 Lumber Transfer

The Bellingham (Wash) Hera'd contains an account of a lumber and railway transfer from the McCoy-Loggie Lumber Company to the St. Paul and Tacoma Lumber Company, involving more than \$1,000,000. The late George W. Loggie was for many years president and J. A. Loggie, the secretary and manager for the former concern. Messrs. Robert and Francis P. Loggie of Loggieville and Andrew Loggie of Dalhousie, are brothers.

The Herald says: A timber and railroad deal involving more than \$1,000,000 and a presaging of the possible construction of a large fir sawmill in Bellingham was concluded at the offices of Hadley and Abbott yesterday afternoon when the Nooksack Timber company organized by interests identified with the St. Paul and Tacoma Lumber company, which operates a mammoth sawmill at Tacoma, purchased the holdings of the McCoy Loggie Timber company on the Middle Fork of the Nooksack river. The transfer includes between 300,000,000 and 400,000,000 feet of lumber, of which 75 per cent is fir and most of the rest cedar and hemlock; fifteen miles of railroad several miles of it recently laid, and all the camp buildings and equipment, which includes locomotives and donkey engines.

Ottawa, Feb. 17—Hon. George P. Graham, acting minister of railways and canals, said in the House of Commons today that the government had completed the purchase of the Caraque and Gulf Shore Railway, and that, with the exception of \$550, the purchase price had been paid. The Department of Railways and Canals at the request of the Department of Justice, had retained this \$550 of the purchase price to protect the claim of the Post Office Department against the railway for loss of registered mail before the road was taken over.
