Sir William Harcourt, who was one of the later arrivals, was loudly cheered as he entered the lobby. The Royal speech proroguing Parliament is unusually brief. It expresses formally regret at the shortness of the recess, releasing members from their labors, and thanks Parliament for its various enactments, and among them the Parish Councils bill and the bill limiting the working hours of railway employes.


