Manitoba wheat is firm. No. 1 hard is quoted at 61c and 62c bid. No. 2 hard at 60c and 61c bid. No. 1 soft at 57c and 58c bid. No. 2 soft at 56c and 57c bid.

FARMERS' MARKET. Receipts of grain were only fair. White wheat was easier, and some poor barley brought considerably lower prices. The market for stock was quiet. Cattle—Butcher, one load of white selling at 55c.
