THE SHARE MARKET

The depression which we noticed last week has continued through the present: Queen Charlotte stock remaining the only exception. The shares in this company have made a further advance, and several transactions have been recorded. We cannot find in the communication lately received from Mr. Burnaby sufficient cause for so great a rise. That the Directors of the British Columbia Company have consented to receive the propositions of the Queen Charlotte Company, and that in a private interview one or two of them spoke favorably of the scheme, may be looked on as a matter of course and courtesy. We sincerely wish Mr. Burnaby success in his mission, but as yet have heard nothing to make us more sanguine than on the day of his departure.

A call of fifty cents on Alberni shares has had the effect of throwing many ... the market, and materially lowering the price.

The coal mine on the American shore of Fuca Strait, to develop which an attempt was made some years since, has been taken up by a new company under the title of the Fuca Straits Coal Mining Company.
